A Glance on the History of the College

Sikh National College, one of the oldest and historical educational institutions of the region, was established in June 1938 at Lahore, with S. Niranjan Singh as its founder principal. It was the dream of the people of the time to build an ideal institute committed to National Ideas, which would mould the character of students into non-communal brotherhood. For the purpose, Principal Niranjan Singh had the backing as well as co-operation of Baba Bhola Singh, Master Kehar Singh, Giani Kartar Singh, Master Tara Singh and Bawa Harkishan Singh Ji. Sikh Educational Society (SES) was registered in Lahore with Baba Bhola Singh, as President and Master Kehar Singh, as the Secretary to manage the college affairs.

As the country edged towards partition in 1947, Sikh National College too had to pay the price. It had to abandon its functioning at Lahore in June 1947. However it was re-established at Qadian in March 1948, with Bawa Harkishan Singh Ji as its first Principal in the Post-Independence Era.

Presently, the Sikh Educational Society (Head Office, Chandigarh) is managing the college affairs, along with five other pioneer educational institutions, SGGS College, GGS College for Women, SGGS College of Pharmacy, SGGS Collegiate Public School, all at Chandigarh and Sikh National College at Banga (Nawa Shehar). Hon'ble S. Gurdev Singh Brar IAS (Retd.) and S. Kulbir Singh Chief Er. (Retd.) are respectively the President and Vice-President. Col (Retd.) Jasmer Singh Bala and S. Karandeep Singh Cheema (Advocate) are respectively the Secretary and Joint-Secretary of the Society.

Vision & Mission

VISION : Sikh National College has always held up the vision to impart education of the highest standard through value-based holistic teaching and learning by integrating traditional and innovative practices. The objective of this institution is to equip students with the skills desired to adapt better to the changing global scenario, refine abilities and aptitudes, and inculcate strong core values to shape them into socially responsible citizens.

The college is affiliated to G. N. D. U., Amritsar for Degree, Diploma & PG courses. The college offers regular courses, like B.A., B.Com., B.Sc.(Non-Medical), B.Sc. Computer Science, B.Sc. Economics and B. A. in Computer Application (Vocational). Full time computer courses, such as D.C.A., B.C.A. and B.Sc. IT, at UG level and PGDCA, M.Sc. IT, M.A. Pbi. at PG level.

C) M.Sc. (IT) ELIGIBILITY :- Graduate with Computer Science/IT/Computer Applications/ Computer Maintenance as one of the Elective Subjects with 50% marks in aggregate.
OR
BCA/B.Sc. (IT)/BIT or equivalent there to with atleast 50% marks in aggregate.



Guidelines & Rules for the Admission

- The parents and students are advised to read the prospectus carefully before filling up the admission form.
- Candidate must fill the admission form in his/her own handwriting. Incomplete admission form will be rejected.
- The following attested documents must be attached with the admission form.
 - A copy of matriculation certificates as a proof of date of birth.
 - Certified copies of certificates/ detailed marks card of having passed the lower examination.
 - Character certificate from the head of the institution last attended as regular student must be attached.
 - Students belonging to SC/ST/BS are required to attach a certificate to the effect from the competent authority.
 - Registration Card (for old students only)
 - Migration Certificate and Eligibility certificate issued G.N.D.U., Amritsar to students who have passed lower examination from board/university other than Punjab board/G.N.D.U. Amritsar.
 - The candidate must affix latest passport photograph on admission form and another photograph on slip attached with admission form for Identity Card.
 - Aadhar Card.
- The subject combination must be filled very carefully out of the subjects offered by the college.
- At the time of admission the candidate must appear in person for the interview.
- Candidate must show all the original certificates to the admission committee at the time of admission.
- Students admitted provisionally to any class are required to submit the original certificates of the examination passed within 30 days of the admission for the issue of University Registration Number to confirm the admission by the University. In case of non-compliance, the admission of the student shall stand cancelled automatically and the fee paid by the student shall not be refunded.
- If a student makes a false declaration or conceals any information in the admission form, his/her admission to the college shall stand cancelled without any notice as soon as the false declaration or the concealed information is detected.
- The Principal reserves the right to refuse the admission to any candidate if he is satisfied that the refusal is in the interest of the college.
- Student whose result of +2 examination is notified as RL (Result Late) by any board will not be allowed admission to higher class even provisionally.
- If the presence and stay of a student in the college is found detrimental to the interest of the college and he/she disturbs the academic environment, he/she may be expelled from the college in the interest of the institution.

- ਜੇਕਰ ਕਿਸੇ ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀ ਦੀ ਕਾਲਜ ਵਿਚ ਮੌਜੂਦਗੀ ਅਤੇ ਪੜ੍ਹਾਈ ਦੀ ਨਿਰੰਤਰਤਾ ਕਾਲਜ ਦੇ ਹਿੱਤਾਂ ਲਈ ਹਾਨੀਕਾਰਕ ਪਾਈ ਜਾਂਦੀ ਹੈ ਤਾਂ ਕਾਲਜ ਦੇ ਹਿੱਤਾਂ ਨੂੰ ਧਿਆਨ ਵਿਚ ਰੱਖਦੇ ਹੋਏ ਉਸਨੂੰ ਕੱਢਿਆ ਜਾ ਸਕਦਾ ਹੈ।

Rules of College Fees

1. The date for the payment of the college dues for the various classes will be fixed and notified by the Principal from time to time.
2. A fine Rs. 10/- per day will be charged for the non-payment of the dues in time.
3. Students absent from the college must arrange to pay their fee within the due date.
4. Cheques/Bank draft will be not be accepted for payment of fees.
5. Non-payment of the College dues within one month of the last day of the payment will render the student liable to be struck off from the college rolls. Studentship can be restored by paying re-admission fee and arrears.
6. It is compulsory for the student to apply to the principal to stuck off his/her name from the college rolls in case he/she does not want to continue the studies. If he/she does not get his/her name struck off then he/she will continue to exist on the college rolls and fee for the full year shall be charged from the student.
7. If student leaves the college during any time he/she will have to pay the fee for the whole period of each term except in case of migration.
8. The fee once paid will not be refunded.
9. A student who come from the other State/Board or University will have to deposit migration fees extra.
10. Fee can be increased or decreased from time to time as per the instructions of the Managing Committee from to time as per the instructions of the Managing Committee and University.
11. Fee concession is not a matter of right for the students. It is the prerogative of the Principal. Fee concession will be granted on the basis of merits of the case.
12. The concession in fee, Scholarship and prizes to students are conditional and are liable to be withdrawn when a students is found indulged in misconduct or irregular in attendance or fail to secure required marks in House Examination. In case a student leaves the college or migrates in the mid session he/she will be required to deposit the amount of benefit given to him/her by way of scholarship fee concession, prize etc.
13. Student coming on their vehicles are liable to pay Rs. 1000/- annually as the parking fees.

Rules for House Examination

1. It is compulsory for every student to appear in the house examination conducted by the college.
2. Fine shall be imposed on the absentees in the house examination.
3. As per the requirement of G.N.D.U., Amritsar a student has to secure minimum marks as started below in house examination. 35% marks in each subject in house examination or 25% marks in aggregate.
NOTE :- Any student who fails to appear/does not qualify in the house examination shall not be allowed to appear in the university examination.
4. Any student found indulged in unfair means during house examination shall be heavily fined or may be expelled from the college.

7. ਜੇ ਕੋਈ ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀ ਆਪਣੀ ਪੜ੍ਹਾਈ ਮੱਧ ਸੈਸ਼ਨ ਦੌਰਾਨ ਛੱਡ ਕੇ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ ਤਾਂ ਮਾਈਗਰੇਸ਼ਨ ਵਾਲੇ ਕੇਸ ਨੂੰ ਛੱਡ ਕੇ ਉਸ ਨੂੰ ਹਰ ਟਰਮ ਦੀ ਪੂਰੀ ਫੀਸ ਦਾ ਭੁਗਤਾਨ ਕਰਨਾ ਪਵੇਗਾ।

Code of Conduct for the Students

1. The parents and the students are required to read the prospectus before signing the admission form. The responsibility of having read the rules regulations will be upon the parents and the students and they will be bound by the same.
2. Each student is issued an Identity Card which he/she must carry. No student will be allowed to enter the college without Identity Card.
3. Student is required to show identity card whenever demanded by security staff & Teachers.
4. Loss of Identity Card shall entail heavy penalty besides the cost of new Identity Card.
5. Do not carry Mobile Phones in college campus. Strict action will be taken against the violators.
6. No student will bring any outside (friend or relative) to the college without the permission of Principal. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against the student who violates the rules and legal action will be taken against the outsiders.
7. Attendance of the students in all college seminars, functions and celebration is compulsory. Fine will be imposed on absentees.
8. Switch off the lights and fans while leaving the classrooms.
9. Take care of college property.
10. Make extensive use of the library.
11. Do not litter the campus. Eatables are not allowed in class room and in academic area.
12. Be punctual and regular in classes.
13. Students are advised to read Notice Board daily.
14. Be humble with the office staff, be polite to juniors and respectful to seniors.
15. Smoking and drinking are strictly prohibited. Any student found drunk or smoking in the college campus will be immediately expelled.
16. Four wheelers of the students are not allowed to be parked in the college campus. These are to be parked outside the college at student's risk.
17. In case of serious misbehavior, indiscipline, disturbance to academic atmosphere of the college, indulging in strike/agitation, preventing the students from attending the classes, unfair means in the examination, the Principal has right to impose fine or cancel the admission and ban the entry of student into the college.
18. Students presence in the college campus is allowed only during college hours. They are not allowed to stay in the campus without any business.
19. Do not pluck flowers.
20. Avoid keeping heavy cash and jewellery in your bags. College is not responsible for the lost items.
21. Two Wheeler of the students will be parked at the marked parking space. Parking fees will be charged from the students.
22. Writing on the switch board is prohibited. Any student found damaging the switch board will be fined.
23. Students are not allowed to write on the college magazines, articles and newspapers lying in the library.

Change In The Faculty/subjects

Students can change their faculty or subjects within 15 days of the admission, after depositing Rs 200 and Rs 100 per subject respectively.

Migration

A student can migrate to other college in mid-session provided:

1. He/She is registered with G. N. D. U., Amritsar.
2. He /She has obtained the written consent of the Principal of the concerned college.
3. He/She has submitted an application form, bearing remarks from both the Principals along with the fee to the Registrar, G. N. D. U., Amritsar.

Infrastructure

Historical Building

The College has a beautiful building with twenty three spacious class rooms and one common room for girls having necessary paraphernalia. This historical building is the pride possession of our town and we are proud to say that the building is almost hundred years of age. The building also houses the new block and newly constructed class rooms.

Canteen

The college has a commodious canteen with separate rooms for the teachers and students. The canteen contractor serves the hygienic food material at reasonable prices. The canteen thus helps students to become refreshed and relaxed.

Laboratories

There are different spacious laboratories for the Chemistry and Physics departments. Each lab has been equipped with the required apparatus to conduct the practical classes.



Computer Lab :

There is a modern fully air conditioned computer lab, which efficiently serves the needs of M Sc IT, PGDCA, BCA, BSc IT and DCA students. The lab has high tech computers with networking and high speed internet facilities. New Desktops, All in One Computers, Laptop, LED Projectors and Printers have also been added in the existing stock.



Guru Hargobind Stadium

The stadium has been constructed to promote sports activities in the college campus. People of the surrounding area and sports persons practice different games during the morning and evening times. With the help of UGC grants and government schemes, the stadium has been expanded further and new rooms have constructed.

Salient Features of The Stadium

1. The stadium has standard, 400 m six lane track.
2. A multipurpose building has been constructed with facilities like change rooms and bathrooms.
3. At one corner of the track, the shooting range, a “Kabbadi” ground, volley ball ground, etc are the additional features of the stadium.
4. The stadium has been equipped with an underground network of water pipes and a submersible pump for supplying water.

Playgrounds

There are separate and spacious playgrounds for games like basketball, football, hockey, cricket, volleyball and badminton.



General Useful Appliances

The college owns two Auditorium and one Seminar Hall with modern audio-visual equipments, like Projector, Screen, CD player, LED TV etc. All modern facilities like Electric Generators, Refrigerator, three Water Coolers fitted with R.O., a Xerox Machine, Fax, Printer, and Scanner are there in the college.

College Library

The Library offers an excellent collection of books and magazines on different subjects. There are approximately 27302 books in the college library. Twenty two daily newspapers (Punjabi, Hindi & English) and thirty-five weekly/Monthly/Annual magazines/periodicals are being subscribed by the college Library. New books are added to the existing stock as per needs and requirements of the students and the staff. Every Year, new books are added to its stock to cater and update the academic requirements.

Salient Features of Library

- 1 The library remains open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- 2 Every student is provided a library I.D. Card, at the time of admission. Books are issued only, on the presentation of the above-mentioned card.
- 3 The library offers the facility to borrow books from its Book Bank to needy, deserving and intelligent students, for the whole academic session.
- 4 The library has been equipped with hi-tech facilities like Internet, Audio-Visual aids, Reprography and Computerized Reference Services.
- 5 In the library, separate accommodation has been managed for boys, girls, postgraduate students and the teaching staff.

Note :

- *It is the duty of library staff, teachers and students to maintain pin-drop silence, inside the library.*
 - *While borrowing a book, students should satisfy themselves that the book is in good condition. If, a book is in improper state, it should immediately be reported to the librarian otherwise, the students will be held responsible to pay for any damage or loss of the book in their possession.*
- All the books must be returned on or before the due date. If, the books are returned after the due date, a fine of Rs. 1 per day would be charged from the student.***

Students Welfare Department

Prof Sukhpal Kaur, Prof. Rakesh Kumar as its incharge, informs and advises students regarding Fee concession, Scholarships and availability of other funds. This department also renders various services like, filling up of free ships and other scholarships for SC and ST students and detects various sources of financial help for them.

Scholarships and Concessions

The college is committed to identify all the financial resources to provide scholarships, free ships and other concessions to the deserving, poor and intelligent students. The fee concession and other scholarships are offered through the funds received from different Trusts like Late (Col.) Ishar Singh Bajwa Memorial Trust, Late Bawa Harkishan Singh Principal Memorial Trust, Bal Family Educational Trust, Hakim Kartar Singh Parkash Kaur Memorial Trust, Mukhtar Singh Sandhu & Mohinder Kaur Sandhu Memorial Trust, Sharma Family Trust, Advocate ArdamanJit Singh Sandhu Trust, Mr. Mehar Singh Mrs. Kartar Kaur Memorial Trust. A cash prize of Rs. 5000/- is given to each student getting merit position in GNDU Examination. All scholarships are sanctioned to the students, qualifying 75% attendance and other requirements. The above-mentioned financial supports are liable to be withdrawn due to poor attendance and other disciplinary reasons.

Mentoring Groups

Each student is assigned a mentoring group with a faculty member as Mentor. The meeting of mentoring groups is held on the last Saturday of every month, where in, a student can seek guidance regarding studies, career opportunities and personal problems. Attendance in the mentoring sessions is compulsory for all students.

Student Associations and Other Societies

In addition to the excellent academic atmosphere, the students are provided opportunities to take part in co-curricular activities. The hidden artistic talents of students are detected and shaped accordingly. Following societies are functioning in the college: -

College Council

The **College Council** comprises senior staff members with Principal as its chairman. It prepares and distributes academic schedule to the staff & students. It also ensures discipline in the college campus.

Student Council

This council is formed every year to establish communication between students and teachers. The council includes three teachers, class representatives, and the presidents of all the societies of the college.

Assembly

An assembly of all the students is held once a month. The students are Assisted with the news, from the sources, like Pb. Govt. and the university. It is mandatory for all students and the teaching staff to be present in the assembly.

NCC

National Cadet Corps unit is working in the College under the supervision of Prof. Satwinder Singh for both Boys & Girls.



N.S.S. Wing

The college has three units (two units for boys and one unit for girls) of National Service Scheme. The N.S.S. wing supports activities like, adult education, health education and other social service programme in an adopted village. The wing also carries out projects like environmental education to the rural masses. Mrs. Sukhpal Kaur and Prof. H.S. Bal are successfully continuing its activities.



Sports Activities

Since “a sound body rests in a sound mind” so, Physical Education has been made an integral part of our education policy. The college owns standard 400-meter track along with separate and spacious playgrounds for games like basketball, football, hockey, cricket, volleyball and badminton. Preference in admission is given to the outstanding sports persons. The Annual Sports Day provides an opportunity to the students of our college to show their talents and skills. The College Gymnasium and Guru Hargobind Stadium are the pride possessions, to promote sports in this part of the state. The college has Cross Country, Weight lifting, Cricket, Hockey teams.



Medical Assistance

As Medical Officer, Dr B S Bhatia along with an expert team of physicians medically examines our students, every year. The college has first-aid facility for the students.

College Magazine

The college magazine “Raavi” is published, which provides a platform to students to manifest their writing capabilities. Students are encouraged to write poems, short stories and essays. Their write-ups are checked and given appropriate space in the college magazine.

Department of Social out Reach Activities

This department has been established to promote the Social responsibility of the college. The College regularly conducts many social out reach programmes with the help of the following :-

ECO CLUB :- To create environmental awareness among college students and teachers by organizing rallies at Public places. This club also take up Activities like Tree Plantation, cleanliness both within and outside the college campus. The club also organizes seminars, debates on environmental issues. Prof. Rakesh Kumar is the nodal officer of ECO Club.

Career Guidance and Information

Its Function is to inform the students about Various Courses, Job Opportunities & other Career related matters.

Grievances Redressal Cell

The cell has been created to find & redress the grievances of students and employees. If some unpleasant incident happens, Prof. Sukhpal Kaur, as its sole heritage, comes forward with suggestions and remedies prevention Discrimination.

Institution Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

The IQAC is functional in the college to ensure quality education and infrastructure for the students. The IQAC shares the feedback of the students, alumni, stakeholders etc to ensure improvement and development in the college campus. The suggestions and recommendations of the IQAC are implemented in the letter and spirit so that the college activities could be run successfully.

NAAC

This College was accredited for the first time by the NAAC in 2004. In the academic session 2014-2015 the college was re-accredited with NAAC. A Team of three experts arrived in the college for three days, the team stayed to inspect and observe the infrastructure and education, being provided by the College and awarded B grade to the college. With re-accreditation from NAAC, the college is now amongst the leading educational institutions of the region. The College is ready to serve the people of the area with qualitative progressive education.

Placement Cell

The Placement Cell has been created in the college with Dr. Gurdeep Singh as the In-charge. The opportunities for the employment of our student are sought after. Students are sent to participate in the Job fairs at different places. Awareness lectures are organized every year to update the college students for various job opportunities.

Caste Based Discrimination Cell
